

# 2010 DIAMOND IN THE RAW

## CELEBRITY & STUNTWOMEN'S AWARDS

These are the official rules and regulations for the 2010 Diamond in the RAW- Celebrity & Stuntwomen's Awards Nominations. We encourage all entrants to read the rules and regulations in their entirety.

### RULES & REGULATIONS

I. Diamond in the RAW-Celebrity & Stuntwomen's Awards is specifically designed for action oriented entertainment professionals, especially stuntwomen in film, commercial and television. All featured films, commercials or televisions must be signatory and under the Screen Actors Guild guidelines or AFTRA contract. All programs exhibited from August 2008-August 2010 are eligible for submission.

II. Categories

***JEWEL OF THE YEAR:*** This award is dedicated to the stuntwoman who consistently generates work due to her talent, work ethic, charisma and personality. In a short essay, please describe the characteristics of this stuntwoman and explain what qualifies her for this category.

***MENTORSHIP AWARD:*** This award is for a stuntwoman or stunt coordinator who has been instrumental in mentoring at least two stuntwomen during their careers. Please describe the mentoring characteristics of the above nominee and provide the names and stunt services of the stuntwomen mentees for this category. The mentor shares their knowledge of the physical and professional nuances of the stunt business, including set etiquette, safety, etc.

***GEM AWARD:*** This award is for a male stunt coordinator, who consistently hires a diverse group of stuntwomen as non-descript and utility performers in stunts as described by the Screen Actors Guild. Please describe and submit footage, which justifies this individual's qualification for this category.

***DYNAMIC DUO AWARD:*** This award is for an action-oriented actress and her stunt double, whose collaboration creates seamless action stunt sequences. Please submit footage which justifies why these two individuals qualify for this category.

***"WOW" AWARD: STUNTWOMAN OF THE YEAR:*** This award recognizes the stuntwoman who has performed phenomenal and memorable stunts in television, movies or commercials from August 2008-August 2010. Please describe and explain along with footage why this nominee deserves the "Stuntwoman of the Year" award for outstanding achievement

### V. Submissions

Nominees and finalists must be active members of the Screen Actors Guild and in good standings. Stunt professionals, directors and producers may only submit one nominee per category. Only Stunt Performers, DGA Directors and PGA producer may submit nominees.

There will be three finalists in all categories except for the Stuntwoman of the Year and GEM Award, which will have five. The Screen Actors Guild research department will verify GEM Award nominees.

Submissions that require footage must be uploaded through YouSend it.com to [info@stuntwomensawards.com](mailto:info@stuntwomensawards.com) or mailed to Diamond in the RAW: 10736 Jefferson Blvd. #464, Culver City, CA. 90230. **When submitting a DVD, please include the time code of the stunt, type of stunt, nominee and year of the show.** All nominations for the Mentorship Award must have maximum of 250 words or less. Eligibility and submissions will be reviewed and researched by members of the Diamond Committee.

Any members of the Diamond committee nominated for any category will be ineligible to vote for that particular award
